#### **Preamble:**

The K J Somaiya Institute of Dharma Studies was constituted by a resolution of the Governing Body of Somaiya Vidyavihar University, on 1st July 2020. It brings together three institutions that have been working independently in the field of Sanskrit and Yoga; Pali and Buddhist Studies and Jain Studies. Together, the faculty of these institutions represent, through their particular areas of interest, the multiple disciplines that form part of religious and cultural studies. There is a strong focus on the study of ancient languages, philosophy, history, art and architecture. In addition, faculty draw upon modern concerns such as social justice and gender equity to reflect on the textual sources.

### **Programme Objectives:**

Ancient Indian literature preserved in Sanskrit, Prakrit and Pali is a vast repository across several genres. This programme has been specifically designed for close reading of a text with a teacher, drawing out meaning with the aid of commentarial materials. Students will also be led through appreciation of the literary composition, as well as the philosophical and historical context.

Every year, students will have the option of studying an entire text or thematic selections from a collection of texts. In the academic year 2023-24, the following texts will be offered:

- 1. Siddha-Hemaśabdānuśāsanam
- 2. The Yoga Upanişads
- 3. Therigatha

Participants will have the option to read **either one or two** of the texts mentioned above, if the timings do not clash.

#### **Programme Outcome:**

1. Siddha-Hemaśabdānuśāsanam:

At the end of successful completion of the programme the student will

- 1. has detailed information on various Prakrit grammarians.
- 2. has a good understanding of the grammar of the Prakrit language.
- 3. understand the various dialects of Prakrit language.
- 2. The Yoga Upanişads:

At the end of successful completion of the programme the student will

- 1. learn Traditional Indian Yoga systems
- 2. understand The philosophy of the Yoga systems
- 3. have knowledge of classical and theoretical foundations of Yogic Concepts in various Yoga Upanişads

# At the end of successful completion of the programme the student will

- 1. understand the life of Buddhist nuns through their autobiographical verses
- 2. develop the capacity to critically review and analyse the text from a feminist perspective

**Eligibility:** Minimum HSC or equivalent examination. Knowledge of Sanskrit, Prakrit or Pali will be helpful but is not essential.

**Duration:** Two Semesters
