Preamble:

The K J Somaiya Institute of Dharma Studies was constituted by a resolution of the Governing Body of Somaiya Vidyavihar University, on 1st July 2020. It brings together three institutions that have been working independently in the field of Sanskrit and Yoga; Pali and Buddhist Studies and Jain Studies.

Of these, Bharatiya Sanskriti Peetham, under which this programme is currently offered, was inaugurated on 20th October 1989, by His Holiness Jagadguru Shankaracharya Jayendra Sarasvati. Until the Somaiya Vidyavihar University was constituted in August 2019, the Centre was affiliated to the Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit University and commenced activities by offering programmes in Sanskrit and Yoga. Bharatiya Sanskriti Peetham was the first academic institution to develop UG and PG programmes in Yogashastra in the city of Mumbai. The PhD programme in Sanskrit and Yogashastra. In addition, affiliation for Ph D in Philosophy, Sanskrit and History was also obtained under the University of Mumbai.

Research activities at the institute have resulted in numerous publications, which were the outcome of collaborations with national and international scholars of repute. One of the highlights of the institution's contribution has been the Programme for Interfaith Understanding, which resulted in seminal research, particularly the Hindu-Christian Dictionary: Essential Terms for Inter-religious Dialogue, which was the outcome of ten years of rigorous research with the Pontifical University, Urbaniana.

Eligibility: HSC or equivalent. Knowledge of basic framework of Paninian Grammar and sutra system of Ashtadhyayi is necessary.

Duration: The course will be conducted over two years and will engage students for 4 hours each week.

Programme Objectives:

The Ashtadhyayi, a text of Sanskrit grammar, was written by Panini more than 2500 years ago. This work consists of approximately 4000 Sutras which formalize every aspect of Sanskrit grammar, including but not limited to phonetics, euphony, derivation, inflexion, syntax and semantics. This text remains an unparalleled treatise of grammar in time as well as across languages and has been a subject of study of every linguistic scholar. Two traditions remain prevalent in studying the Ashtadhyayi. One is that which follows the Kashika-vrtti of Jayaditya and Vamana which explains Sutras in their original order, while the other is that which adopts an operation-based (prakriya) approach. The Vaiyakarana-Siddhanta-kaumudi of Bhattoji Dikshit has now become the standard prakriya-text. Both traditions have their advantages and it is necessary that the student familiarizes oneself with both these texts for a proper understanding of the Ashtadhyayi.

Course Objectives:

This course teaches the structure and scheme of the Ashtadhyayi. It also teaches the special arrangement of Varnas as well as concentrates in the Phonetics of the language. It then introduces various Samjnas - technical terms of grammar, Paribhashas - interpretational rules of Panini's meta-language, as well as Sutras relating to Sandhi - euphony in the original order of the Ashtadhyayi. It also teaches Taddhitas - secondary nominal derivatives and compound formations as per the Sutras of Ashtadhyayi.

Course Outcomes:

At the end of successful completion of the course the students will be able to understand the Structure of the Ashtadhyayi along with its Samjnas and Paribhashas. Further one shall learn various Sutras that relate to Sandhis, Taddhitas and compounds.
